Retirees and students will participate in short courses together, since research has shown that most retirees have little interest in full-length courses. Anton Creutzfeldt points out that he has already taken courses with older people. "They don't care if they fail," he says. "Older people will go on and on about something that interests them, or that they have personal experience with. It makes things difficult for us because we are
30 just trying to get through the course."

VII College officials are confident that both students and retirees will benefit from this integration project. Older people with experience as doctors, lawyers or musicians can serve as mentors to students, while a college campus can provide a more stimulating environment for older people than most retirement communities.
