The General Assembly,

Reaffirming support for a just, lasting and comprehensive peace between Israelis and Palestinians.

Recognizing that all acts of violence against civilians, particularly acts of terror, as well as all acts of provocation, incitement and destruction only serve to erode trust and hinder efforts to bring about a peaceful solution,

- 1. *Condemns* Hamas for repeatedly firing rockets into Israel and for inciting violence, thereby putting civilians at risk;
- 2. *Demands* that Hamas cease all provocative actions and violent activity, including by using airborne incendiary devices;
- 3. Further condemns the diversion of resources in Gaza to construct military infrastructure, including tunnels to infiltrate Israel and equipment to launch rockets into civilian areas, when such resources could be used to address the critical needs of the civilian population;
- 4. Calls for the cessation of all forms of violence and intimidation directed against medical and humanitarian personnel, and reiterates the importance of respecting the inviolability and neutrality of UN premises;
- 5. Welcomes and urges further engagement by the Secretary-General and the United Nations Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process to assist, in cooperation with concerned partners, in the efforts to de-escalate the situation and address urgent infrastructure, humanitarian, and economic development needs;
